### FITASC ELECTORAL RULES

Elections for all Fitasc bodies are held every four years.

Candidates must be proposed by their national groupings of origin.

If the outgoing Chairman and/or General Secretary wishes to stand for re-election to the same post, they may put their names forward directly to the electoral general assembly, subject to the same timescale conditions as the other candidates, in which case their home federations will be entitled to propose other candidates for the same posts.

The candidates for the technical discipline committees may be proposed solely by national groupings for those disciplines for which they belong to the Fitasc.

## ELECTORAL PROCEDURE

### **Election of the Election Committee**

The Election Committee is formed by two members elected from among the members' delegates present at the general assembly and ensures the smooth running of the elections in accordance with the rules and in the following order:

## 1. Election of the Fitasc Chairman

The Election Committee announces the official candidatures for the post of Chairman and the election is conducted in accordance with Article 6.13.2 of the articles of association. The election of the Chairman requires a simple majority vote of the members represented.

### 2. Election of the Executive Committee

The elected Chairman proposes his/her list of candidates, comprising him/herself, a maximum of five deputy chairmen (cf. Article 8.1 of the articles of association) and a general secretary / treasurer, and puts this list to the vote. The election is conducted in accordance with Article 6.13.2 of the articles of association. The election of the full list requires a simple majority vote of the members represented. If the list is rejected, the Chairman suspends the meeting for a short time in order to present a new list.

# 3. Election of the other eight Management Committee members

The Election Committee announces the official candidatures for the eight Management Committee posts and the election is conducted in accordance with Article 6.13.2 of the articles of association. If there are more candidates than posts to be filled, the candidates receiving the most votes are elected.

# 4. <u>Technical discipline committee members</u>

See Articles 9.3 and 9.4 of the articles of association.

The present electoral rules were approved at the Fitasc's extraordinary general assembly on 14<sup>th</sup> August 2012 in Lincolnshire, USA, and replace the version drawn up on 13<sup>th</sup> July 2010.
